- Provide assessment and care of the patient's airway, hemodynamic status, pain and nausea management
- Facilitates the patient's physical & psychological preparation for surgery & discharge
- Ensures a smooth progression of the patient through the peri-operative phase with strong assessment & critical thinking skills
- Provide extensive pre and post-operative health education, teaching and support to patients & their families, including telephone follow-up calls documented online
- Participation in education activities to advance and maintain competency in care of pre and post-operative patients
- May be required to work in other areas of the Surgical Services program
