This year marks the 22nd anniversary of what came to be known as the Montreal Massacre. On Dec. 6, 1989, Marc Lépine walked through l'École Polytechnique in Montreal, separated the men from the women, and then proceeded to shoot and kill 14 women while making anti-woman statements.

On the anniversary of this sad day, Women's College Hospital will reflect on violence against women and remember the women who have tragically lost their lives to gender-based violence.
