An exciting temporary part-time (approximately one year) opportunity as a **Research Associate (Competition #109.18)** exists in the Women's College Research Institute reporting to the Principle Investigator.

The successful candidate for this role will oversee and participate in a number of epidemiological and other research projects. This may include: observational studies (e.g. retrospective chart reviews or surveys, administrative database analysis, prospective cohort studies, registries), systematic literature reviews, meta-analyses, cost-effectiveness and budget impact models, modeling, risk-benefit analysis, and preparation of value dossiers for health technology assessment.

Summary of Duties, but not limited to:

- Contributes to the content development of proposals and study protocols, in consultation with methodological and clinical experts as needed
- Provides statistical expertise in the design, analysis, and reporting of research projects and consultative assistance for ad hoc requests
- Provides content expertise and leadership on a day-to-day basis, while liaising with methodological experts within a network of scientific collaborators, for additional senior guidance
- Applies project management skills to manage multiple projects simultaneously, help ensure client satisfaction, and adhere to budgets and timelines
- Demonstrates strong teamwork abilities, as a team leader and when taking on a support role, to work effectively in a complex business environment including remote staff, subcontractors and external collaborators
- Develops strategies for solving scientific/technical problems within the Practice
- Leads and engages effectively with project teams to implement the study protocols
- Trains, mentors, and leads staff development
- Contributes to systematic reviews
- Contributes to publication of study methods and results
- Conducts literature searches
