This year marks the 23rd anniversary of what came to be known as the Montreal Massacre. On Dec. 6, 1989, Marc Lepine entered L'Ecole Polytechnique in Montreal, separated the men from the women, and then proceeded to shoot and kill 14 women while making anti-woman statements.
