## Signs of an Overdose



Soft/no breath or snoring



**Pinpoint** pupils



Blue lips, nails, or skin



Cold, clammy skin



body



Doesn't respond to shouting

## **Call 911**

## Give Naloxone



Break drug ampoule



Pull into needle slowly



Inject into large muscle

### Check The Person's Breathing

### Breathing



· Hand supports head Knee stops body from rolling onto stomach

Put person in recovery position

Push hard and fast in center of chest to the beat of Stayin' Alive



Give compressions until help arrives

## Stay Calm

Don't put them in a bathtub/shower Wait for help to arrive

Don't inject stimulants (ie. meth) Don't stand them up
