For the time period: 2020-2022

### Criteria for Application

#### **Purpose:**

These awards will:

- ◆ Recognize excellence in the education of students (undergraduate, postgraduate, graduate, continuing education, pre-clinical/clinical & non-clinical) in any program at WCH
- ◆ Recognize excellence in interprofessional education at WCH
- ◆ Recognize excellence in education scholarship
- ◆ Recognize collaboration in patient education

#### **Nominations:**

Please nominate:

- ◆ teachers at WCH who have inspired, mentored, or pioneered an innovative learning experience
- ◆ teachers based at WCH for a minimum of one year
- ◆ teaching health care professionals who are staff, physicians, or university faculty
- ◆ educators involved in education scholarship
- ◆ educators involved in collaborative projects

#### **We welcome nominations from:**

- ◆ learners/students, staff, physicians, and volunteers
- ◆ clinical education coordinators, education leads
- ◆ managers and department chiefs
- ◆ collaborating teachers & peers
- ◆ education scholars and researchers
- ◆ self

#### **Award Categories:**

##### **The Teacher-Educator/New Teacher/Educator Award**

To recognize an individual who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to teaching or to supervision of students/learners at WCH. Nominations should emphasize the supervisor's skills in areas such as: organization of the education experience; provision of constructive, balanced feedback; and creation of a positive student-supervisor relationship. Up to 2 awards will be reserved for new teachers, recognizing overall excellence in teaching or supervision of students/learners, among members in their first three years at Women's College Hospital.

*Up to six (6) individual Teaching/Educator Awards will be presented.*

### **The Interprofessional Education/Interprofessional Care Award**

Awarded to an individual or group of individuals who have collaborated across departments or disciplines to i) educate learners/students using diverse learning methodologies, ii) provide and support others with ambulatory care education, iii) build interprofessional care/ team-based competencies

*Up to two (2) Collaborative Care Education Awards will be presented.*

### **The Education Innovation Award**

This award recognizes an individual or group who has had an impact on the WCH education/interprofessional education activities in alignment with the strategic directions of the hospital such as virtual care; equity, diversity, and inclusion; or models of teaching/supervision. This could be in relation to learner/student and faculty support such as mentoring, administrative activities, organizational activities, curriculum, and staff development.

*Up to two (2) Education Innovation Awards will be presented.*

### **The Education Scholarship Award**

Awarded to an individual or group of individuals at Women's College Hospital who have advanced the scholarly understanding of educational processes or practices, this can be through curriculum development, faculty development, presentations, publications, and research in education

*Up to two (2) Education Scholarship Awards will be presented.*

### **The Learner/Student as Teacher Award**

Awarded to an individual Learners/Students who have demonstrated excellence in the teaching of peers, junior students/learners, at Women's College Hospital.

*Up to two (2) Trainee as Teacher awards will be presented*

### **The Patient Education Award**

Awarded to an individual or group of individuals who have demonstrated excellence in the teaching of patients at WCH, including creative approaches to communication, developing and/or disseminating patient education, or the developed tools and resources.

*(1) Patient Education award will be presented*

### **The Education Coordinator/Program Administrators Education Award**

This award is given to an individual who works in an administrative role such as a program administrator, program coordinator, education coordinator, or administrative assistant who may not work directly with learners/students but supports education and/or the education program. This individual consistently exhibits a commitment to enhancing the program and student/learner experience through innovative program planning and process improvements and repeatedly demonstrates outstanding advocacy for students/learners and excellence in supporting all aspects of student/learner education.

*(1) Education Program Administrator award will be presented*

**Nomination Process:**

- ◆ Nominations may be submitted at any time of the year, but no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
- ◆ The nomination form must be completed and can be submitted electronically or in paper form.
